How your group balances the cognitive, behavioral and affective dimensions

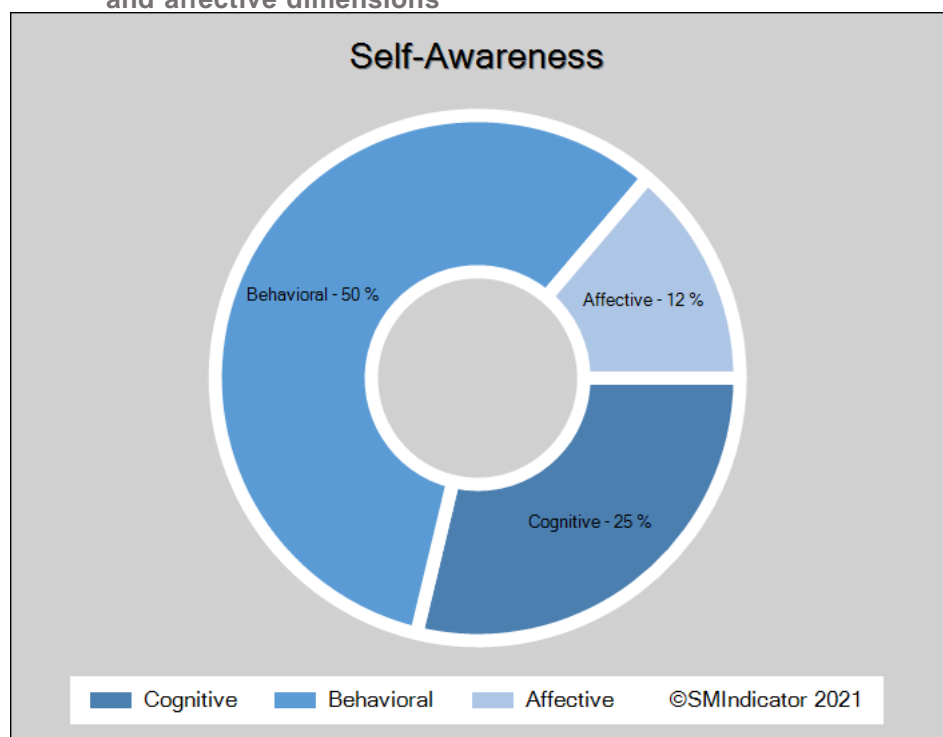
